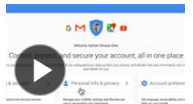
The first 125-seat CS100 was handed over to the unit of Deutsche Lufthansa AG, and is due to depart for Zurich from the plane maker's...

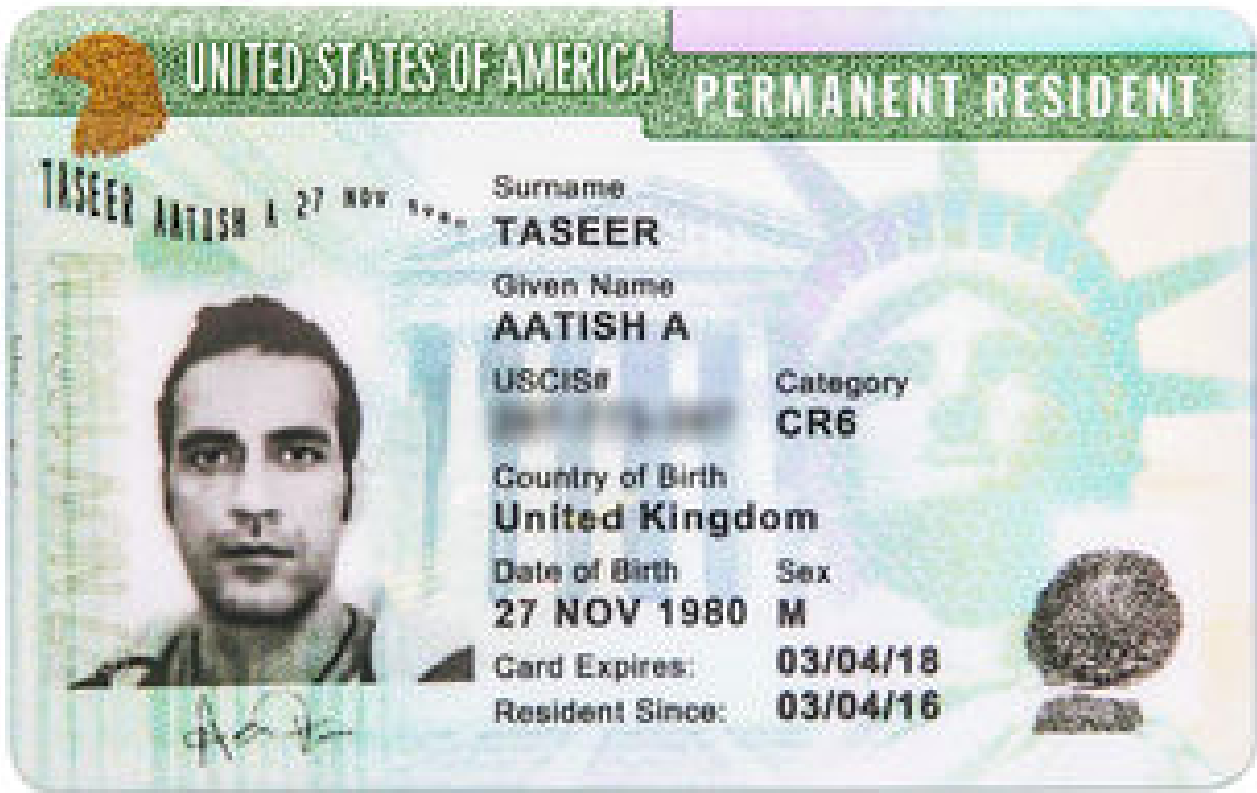

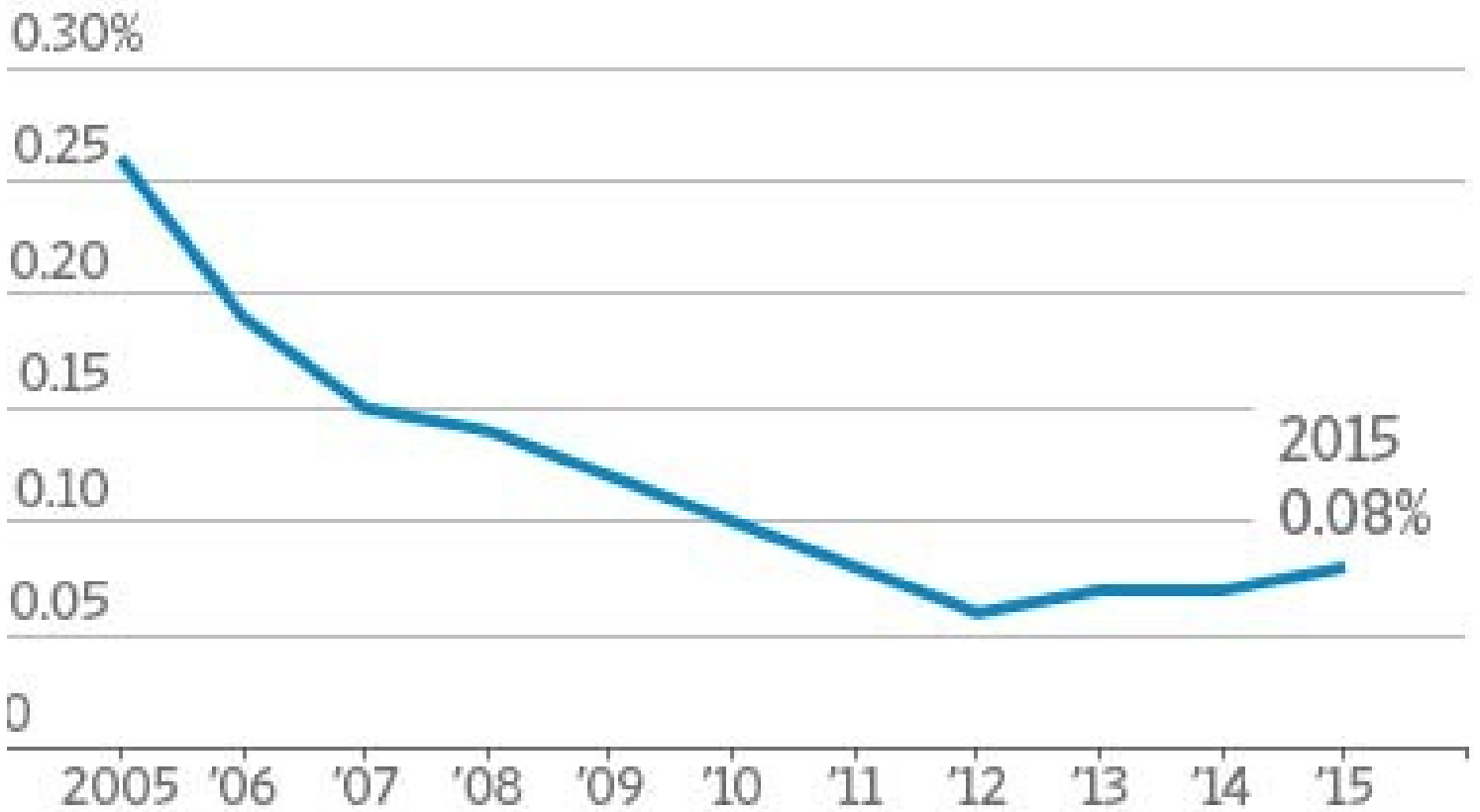
